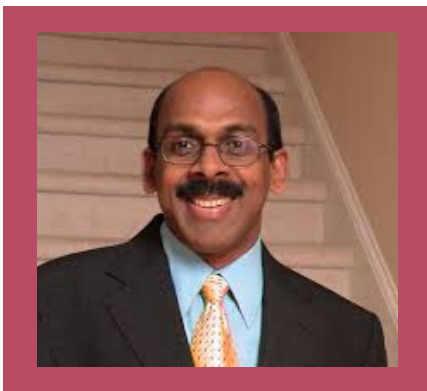


# OUR PHYSICS & ASTRONOMY FACULTY

Dr. Hakkila acts as both the Associate Dean of the Graduate School and a professor for the Physics Department. He is also an active committee member for our students.

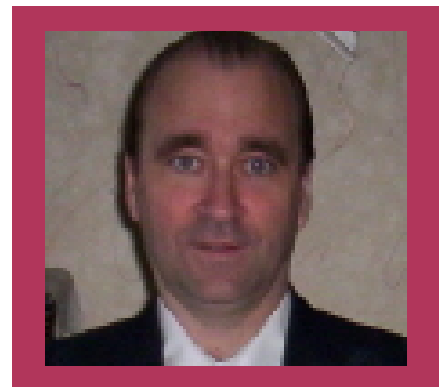


## DR. NARAYANAN KUTHIRUMMAL
